Alice Springs Cycling Club 2018 Road Race Calendar

Nominated race directors are to take responsibility for organising the event including finding additional support for marshalling, timekeeping and course-setting. If unable to direct a race the nominated person needs to swap with someone else or contact the ASCC committee to arrange a swap. All riders from 2017 are expected to assist by directing or assisting with at least one race. Contact committee members to obtain advice regarding race details and equipment requirements. The race box can usually be collected from the previous race director or the clubrooms.

All riders are required to have a current Cycling Australia licence or are to take out a day licence prior to the race:

- Ride Basic, Ride+ or Race licence for Gran Fondos, Time Trials, Cyclocross and MTB/road joint social events
- Race license only for all other events – track racing, criteriums, grade races and handicaps.

Licences are to be presented to the commissaire at sign-on. Riders who do not present evidence of a valid licence will not be allowed to race.

All riders are required to wear race numbers. These will be provided at the event sign-on. Two race numbers are to be positioned low on the rear of the jersey one on the left, one on the right for all road events except individual time trial and team time trial where one number shall be worn.

Series points are not transferable between grades.

Junior grades 20 minutes + 1 lap

C Grade 15 minutes + 1 lap

B Grade 20 minutes + 1 lap

A Grade 20 minutes + 1 lap

The final lap will commence when the leading rider crosses the line following the completion of the race time.

Lapped riders will finish in order behind the lead rider but have their position adjusted in accordance with their lap deficit.

Lapped riders may be pulled from the race at the Race Director's / Commissaire's discretion.

Lapped riders are not to influence the outcome of the race.

Riders may miss a lap and rejoin the race following a mechanical failure.

Series grade winners shall be based on accumulated points.

Points are awarded for starting, finishing and for the first 3 places as per the table above.

Points do not count towards the Road Points Series.

R16 Standley Chasm (Club Road Race Championship)

All riders will be graded into A, B, C and Social grades.

Riders will nominate their grade. Riders are strongly encouraged to nominate for the grade most appropriate to their ability.

Adjustments of grades may be made by the Race Director/handicapper as appropriate.

Grade Series points are not transferable between grades.

Points from any grade contribute to the Road Series Points.

A and B grades may be started together where the race distance is equal and either grade has less than 5 riders or if there are insufficient numbers to race separately. All grades that start together may race together.

Grades that start separately must race separately. For example if A & B grade start separately then A and B grade riders may not draft each other.

Social riders may be started with C Grade.

No times, places or competition points will be awarded for social riders.

Series grade winners shall be based on accumulated points.

The Club Road Race Grade Championship is determined from the grade results from the one race.

Grade Race points count towards the Road Race Series.

Time Trial Series

5 events make up the Time Trial Series;

- R6 10km short course time trial Darken Drive
- R7 10km short course time trial Darken Drive
- R8 Individual time trial 20km Santa Teresa Rd
- R8 Individual time trial 20km Santa Teresa Rd
- R17 Club Championship time trial 20km Santa Teresa Rd

The time trial series has an overall point classification and division categories tabled below. No grade classifications apply to time trials.

SERIES OVERALL CLASSIFICATION

Time trial series have points awarded in accordance with the table determining an Overall Classification and contributing to the series aggregate.

All places below 8th receive 5 points. Starters who do not finish receive 2 point.

Overall Classification Points from the two longer time trials contribute to the Road Points Series.

SERIES DIVISIONAL CLASSIFICATION

The time trials series has points awarded in accordance with the table determining the divisional classifications and contributing to the series divisional aggregates. Riders may qualify for more than one division (for example, female and masters 50+).

The Junior series is conducted over 3 races – the 2 short course and the club championship.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISIONS.

The Club Championship has the following divisions: Male, Female and Junior (U17, U15 & U13).

Race directors do not receive points. Directors may delegate role to other suitably experienced persons and still race.

Mass start, with male and female, junior and seniors for each race

Adjustments of grades may be made by the Race Director/Commissaire as appropriate.

Series points are not transferable between grades.

Juniors 20 minutes + 1 lap

Seniors 20 minutes + 1 lap

The final lap will commence when the leading rider crosses the line following the completion of the race time.

Lapped riders will finish in order behind the lead rider but have their position adjusted in accordance with their lap deficit.

Lapped riders may be pulled from the race at the Race Director's / Commissaire's discretion.

Lapped riders are not to influence the outcome of the race.

Riders may miss a lap and rejoin the race following a mechanical failure.

Series grade winners shall be based on accumulated points.

Points are awarded for starting, finishing and for the first 3 places as per the table above.

Points do not count towards the Road Points Series.
